

MINUTES

The meeting was called to order at 5:30pm by Jack Byrnes, Chairman.

The April 5, 2022 Agenda and February 1, 2022 Minutes were accepted and approved.

Old Business

- * Seven Devils American Red Cross Emergency Shelter- Wayne Bonomo has been in contact with the American Red Cross to get a better understanding of policies, procedures, needs/equipment required, volunteer training, etc. A representative will be out later this month to see our site at the Community Center and answer questions.
- * Brad Lambert updated on concerns raised at the February 1, 2022 meeting:
 1. Police Chief Johnathan Harris said daily drive-bys are made each shift.
 2. DOT has the dropoff - "tank trap" - on the right side of Seven Devils Road first curve downhill (below the Inn) on their workorder list (timing, \$???). Question - can a CAUTION sign be put there to warn people?
 3. More lights have been put on the sign at the bottom alerting drivers that 4 wheel drive and/or chains are required under adverse weather conditions.
 4. The pavement at the foot of the steps and ramp at the Community Center are checked for black ice. Salt is put down if necessary. A bucket of salt is also in the supply closet by the kitchen.

New Business

- * Would it be possible for the Public Safety Committee Meetings be available to attend/view virtually so others can hear concerns addressed and perhaps raised concerns they've noticed. The Public Safety Committee goal is to address health, safety and welfare in Seven Devils and surrounding area. Jack Byrnes will check the Seven Devils Public Safety Committee status.

There will not be a May meeting. Our next scheduled meeting will be June 7, 2022.
