Status of 2014 Public Works projects:

Otter Falls - Project complete. The voluntary participation of PW personnel in the opening ceremonies of Otter Falls was briefly discussed. (CLOSED)

Snowcloud Water Project – Project complete including new pipe, new meters road repairs. Kevin Aldridge noted that the Town had some incidents this winter of water meter freezing. He noted that although that meter freezing is not common, it can occur during wintertimes that are very cold without the insulating layer of snow on top of the meter. Complete. (CLOSED)

Road paving recommendations:

Patching of the asphalt is ongoing. (OPEN)

New Town electronic sign:

Complaints concerning the electronic sign have become rare. The Town Manger’s plan concerning management of the time of use and info provided has ameliorated negativity. The announcing of important information has been particularly advantageous citizens and tourists. (CLOSED)
