

**Town of Seven Devils
Recreation Commission
Minutes—Regular Session
July 13, 2017**

The Town of Seven Devils Recreation Commission met at 9:00 a.m. in Town Hall on July 13, 2017. Members present were Bob Bridges, Ed Beck, Anne Fontaine, Kay Lambert, Leigh Sasse, and Martha Stearns. Skip Watts was absent. Town Manager Debbie Powers and Brad Lambert were also present.

Kay Lambert made a motion that we accept the agenda and the June 15, 2017, minutes. Leigh Sasse seconded the motion, and the agenda and the June minutes were approved.

Ed Beck reported on The Hawk. Seventeen people have registered—13 runners, 1 walker, and 3 Phantom Hawks. Donations total \$440, and runner fees are \$425, a total of \$865. There are six sponsors at this time. Ed displayed a map of the route with four designated aid stations. There may be enough volunteers to provide more aid stations. There was a discussion about what to include in a bag for all runners. We will make a decision at the August meeting. We decided to award the fastest male and female runners with a full-size devil's food cake in addition to other prizes. Other winners would receive a smaller cake. A label on the cakes will be "The Hawk at Seven Devils Takes the Cake." Winners will also receive Seven Devils hats and mugs, and there will be a booth selling these items to others. We will put an insert depicting the route into water bills so that residents along the route will be aware.

Paige Patterson from the county extension service will speak about using native plants in landscapes at Town Hall on Friday, July 14 at 10:00.

An outdoor movie will be shown at Town Hall on Friday, July 21. Boone Rentals will set up the screen, projector, and sound system, and the movie will start at dusk.

Approximately 103 people attended the Johnson Brothers concert on June 23, 2017. Attendance was probably suppressed by construction and wrecks on Highway 105. The Amantha Mill concert will be on August 11 at the resort club.

Attendance at ranger workshops has not been good, possibly because of weather or people not being aware of the event. The next ranger workshop is August 4 at Otter Falls, and we will put up a sign in front of Town Hall announcing it. We will also make an announcement about it at the movie on July 14.

Anne Fontaine said the Recreation Commission has \$700 in the Partnership for a Better Seven Devils that we can use if the need arises.

Debbie Powers said that all Peak Mountain trail grant paperwork has been turned in, and we should know if we will receive it by late September or early October.

Leigh Sasse made a motion to adjourn. Ed Beck seconded the motion, and the meeting was adjourned.
