

**TOWN OF SEVEN DEVILS
MINUTES – TOWN COUNCIL
BUDGET WORKSHOP**

April 24, 2014

The Seven Devils Town Council met for the second of their annual Budget Workshops at Town Hall on Thursday, April 24, 2014. Present were Mayor Larry Fontaine, Mayor Pro Tem Brad Lambert, and Members Kay Ehlinger and David Ehmig. Member David Hooper was absent. Also present was Town Manager Ed Evans, who recorded the minutes.

CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Fontaine called the meeting to order at 9:05 AM following the previous night's 'Recess' at the Otter Falls Public Hearing.

PRELIMINARY BUDGET DISCUSSION—Manager Evans and the Town Council again discussed the Preliminary Budget. Discussions about water infrastructure funding for Snowcloud resulted in authorization for the Manager to explore potential loans for the project. Discussion also ensued regarding the possible construction of a building for storing our winter chat and possible addition of a new police car. Additional capital projects were discussed and changes to the existing 'preliminary budget' were to be made and brought back to the Council at a called budget workshop on May 12, 2014.

Funding for the Otter Falls trail system was also discussed and Mayor Pro Tem Lambert made a motion to move forward and build the trail system. Member Ehmig seconded the motion. All Members supported this initiative with an affirmative vote and the motion was adopted.

RECESS

Being no further business, Mayor Pro Tem Lambert, at 11:10 AM, made a motion to recess until 9:00 AM on May 12, 2014. Member Ehlinger seconded the motion and all agreed unanimously. The meeting was recessed.
